Career Highlights & Achievements:

- Pioneering Clinical Research: Dr.
 Adams led two National Institutes of Health-funded, multi-center clinical trials—the first randomized trials focused on stroke prevention in sickle cell disease and any pediatric condition.
- Innovating Rural Healthcare
 Access: He established the REACH
 MUSC Stroke Network, the first hub of
 a statewide telemedicine system
 delivering evidence-based stroke care
 to underserved rural communities
 across South Carolina.
- Addressing Health Disparities: Dr.
 Adams served as the principal investigator for the WISSDOM Center, a collaborative project funded by the American Heart Association. This initiative brought together interdisciplinary researchers to understand and address disparities in stroke recovery outcomes.
