


### **First Annual Silent Auction**

On April 12th, our chapter hosted its first-ever Silent Auction in support of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital—and it was a tremendous success. Thanks to the generosity of local businesses and over 20 attendees, we raised \$8,000 in a single evening.

This event was driven by the outstanding leadership of Prytanis Anthony Fahim and the dedicated efforts of our Philanthropy Committee. As a result, our chapter has now raised a total of \$27,000 for St. Jude, officially surpassing the previous Saint Louis University fundraising record of \$19,000 set by Sigma Chi.
