


Iota-Kappa Chapter

We would like to highlight a major accomplishment of two of our brothers. Jack Lamuraglia (2021) and Tanner Wallace (2021) have created a successful business. Their business, KLAW Industries, is paid by recycling facilities to take contaminated glass that is destined for landfills. They then use their patent-pending process to turn the glass into *Pantheon*, which is then sold to concrete manufacturers. *Pantheon* can replace 30% of cement in concrete making it stronger, more chemically resistant and more environmentally friendly.
