Covid-19 Updates

As announced earlier this month, The chapter voted in a new policy for visitors at the TKE house shown below:

"All guests planning on visiting and/or staying at the TKE House and are not a part of the regular Clarkson Community, are being asked to either receive a PCR test within 72 hours to arrival on campus or a rapid COVID test within 24 hours. The result of the test must be sent to the Pylortes before arrival on campus. Furthermore, guests are required to register with Clarkson, either through Human Resources or Residence Life, to be considered a valid guest on campus."

As always, we are happy to host any visiting alumni, but we chose to take extra precautions to prevent COVID disruptions to the new member process, TKE Week, and many of our other initiatives during the spring semester. Any future changes will be communicated through email and the newsletter.
