This month, Frater Eliot Keith competed in the Landmark Conference Swimming Championship on February 15-18th in Baltimore. This was the last competition of his collegiate swimming career. He qualified in finals for all three events that he participated in and became the first Lycoming male swimmer to qualify for a finals championship race in the Landmark Conference. Eliot also became the 4th fastest performer in program history in the 100-yard breaststroke. In his swimming career, Frater Eliot Keith swam for the Lycoming College swim team for three years and served as Team Captain during the 2023-2024 season. Eliot is the only Lycoming swimmer to ever earn athlete of the week awards from two different conferences. He was the first ever Lycoming swimmer to earn the Landmark Conference Athlete of the Week Award.
